

## **Trinity Academy Exclusion Sanction Guide**

## Scale & scope

This guidance is not intended to suggest that any form of adverse behaviour is acceptable – but is intended to inform investigation & response in proportion to the offence. It is also designed to promote consistency in the way Heads of Learning & Senior Leadership respond. This chart must be considered in the context of the exclusion policy and in the context of academy practice as outlined in the internal and external exclusion guide.

All staff are reminded that only the Headteacher can sanction exclusion; all incidents must be investigated; all incidents require professional judgement.

## **Types of Behaviour**

In line with the exclusions policy, behaviours that require investigation and sanction include:

	physical	assault	against a	student

> verbal abuse/threatening behaviour against student

bullying

> sexual misconduct

damage

persistent disruptive behaviour

> physical assault against an adult

> verbal abuse/threatening behaviour against an adult

racist abuse

drug and alcohol related

> theft

> weapons related

Within this, anti-social behaviours which may result in a permanent exclusion for a 'one off' serious offence include:

- serious actual or threatened violence against another student or a member of staff
- supplying an illegal drug

sexual abuse or assault

> carrying an offensive weapon /knife
